### Objectives of the Event:


To provide free services to the community like, free eye check-up and advice; spectacles at affordable rates; free blood pressure check-up; arrangement for cataract surgery at affordable prices.

#### Description of the Activity:



2. To create awareness among students about the importance of plantation and keeping the campus green.


### Description of the Activity:

Objectives of the Event: The Special Camp will fulfill the following goals of:

- 1. Understanding the community and identifying community needs by volunteers
- 2. Developing social responsibility, leadership and personality among the volunteers
- 3. Gaining skills and preparing for emergencies by volunteers
- 4. Practicing national integration and strengthening bonds for promoting brotherhood and communal harmony.

#### Description of the Activity:

The NSS Unit, Nehru College, pailapool has organized a Seven Day NSS Special Camp from 10/09/2024 to 17/09/2024 with its volunteers in the campus, adopted village and surroundings. The Camp was inaugurated by Dr. Shuvajit Chakraborty, Principal, on 10/09/2024 along with the presence of Dr. L. Bharati Singha, Academic Co-ordinator and Dr. Madhumita Das, IQAC Co-ordinator, staff and NSS Volunteers. In narrating the importance of organizing Special Camp, Dr. Chakraborty, Principal, has stated that participation of volunteers in the camp would make them a responsible citizen in near future who would fulfill the community needs, develop leadership quality among themselves, take the lead to uplift the society. On 10/07/2024 (Day 1) the programme was organized in Labacpar Pt-III 7 No. Basti, the adopted village of Nehru College where notebooks and other stationeries were distributed among the children of adopted village. The villagers along with children were made realized about the importance of education in life and how the present-day government policies are centered on child's education by providing free and

compulsory education on the part of government. On 11/09/2024 (Day 2) an awareness programme on Women's Health, Hygiene & Cancer was organized in the same adopted village in collaboration with Burrows Memorial Christian Hospital, Alipur. From the Hospital, Dr. Joel Stephen George, Medical Officer was present along with his medical team that included Ms. Faith Panmei, Nursing Officer; Mr. James Das, Nurse Anestheist; Mr. Junaton Surin, Staff Nurse; Ms. Archana Masih, Staff Nurse. The Medical Officer and the team spoke on the issue of women's health, hygiene & cancer and physical examination of the village members was conducted by the team also. On 12/09/2024 (Day 3) the Programme Officer along with Dr. Momota Chakraborty, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Bengali, as resource person and volunteers went to 1339 No. Labac Part IV LP School, Pailapool, Cachar where an interactive programme was conducted with more than hundred of primary students. The programme was basically an awareness one on "Poshan Bhi Padhai Bhi (PBPB)" which was again one of the core theme of Rastriva Poshan Maah. The resource person talked about the importance of nutritious food for children along with education that keep them healthy and be helpful towards their education. The volunteers made practice the students their course of studies also. On 13/09/2024 (Day 4) the programme was held in college campus. It was 'ABHA Registration and Reuse of Waste Paper' by the NSS Volunteers. The volunteers helped the people of the locality and many students in getting their registration for ABHA; apart from that volunteers have made paper bags with waste paper so as to spread the message of keeping the environment plasticfree and emphasizing the use of paper bags in place of plastic bags. On 14/09/2024 (Day 5) the NSS Volunteers along with Programme Officer and other faculty members have organized a Awareness Rally on HIV/AIDS & Anti-Drug from College to Pailapool Point. The Volunteers hold play card with different messages. On 16/09/2024 (Day 6) Cleanliness Drive was arranged and volunteers participated in the same by enthusiastically and cleaned the college campus and surroundings. On 17/09/2024 (Day 5) the programme was organized in the college campus. It was a skill development programme for the women. Women were given training in tailoring which women could opt as means of livelihood also. In that programme, a resource person was invited named Smt. Deboshri Saha, Trainer / Assessor from Joypur Pt. I. The Seven Day NSS Special Camp ended with a valedictory session in which Sri Tapos Deb, Principal, SM Dev College, Lakhipur was present as Chief Guest. The Programme ended with a vote of thanks.

## Description of the Activity:


