

ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS FEEDBACK SESSION: 2023-24 NEHRU COLLEGE, PAILAPOOL

Feedbacks were collected from students on teachers, teaching-learning process, evaluation process and infrastructure of the institution. The data collected are analyzed and results are graphically presented below:






A total of 214 students submitted feedbacks on aspects like teachers, teaching-learning process, evaluation process, and infrastructure. 37.85 percent and 62.15 percent of the respondents are male and female respectively (Figure 1). Among male students, majority of the respondents (69.14 percent) are from Second Semester of FYUG Programme, followed by TDC 4th and 6th Semester students. Similarly, 57.14 percent female respondents are from second semester of FYUG Programme. It shows that nearly two-third of the respondents are from second semester of FYUG Programme (Figure 1).

Figure 2 depicts the composition of Core/ Major students from various department. Out of the 214 respondents, nearly 57 percent are from two departments, namely, English (28.5 percent) and Political Science (28.5 percent), followed by Bengali department (16.8 percent). Very few respondents are from departments like Economics (2.34 percent), History (2.8 percent), Hindi (4.67 percent) and Manipuri (7.94 percent).




3. Teachers' preparation for the class. 214 responses


















11. Teachers' approach to teaching can best be described as 214 responses








17. Availability of reading space in library. 214 responses








20. Role of principal in maintenance of discipline and order in the college campus. 214 responses





Summary of the report:

- Majority of the students are satisfied with the teachers in all the aspects covered in the feedback. However, nearly one-fourth of students have raised concern over noncompletion of syllabus in time.
- 2. Close to 8 percent students feels that teachers are not very acquainted with the use of new techniques, methodology and ICT tools in teaching.
- Students showed satisfaction regarding availability of prescribed books and materials
 in the library. However, they have also reported about unavailability of books and
 materials for competitive examinations.
- 4. Although, a very high number of students are satisfied with the cooperation of library staff. But there are around 15 percent students who felt need for more cooperation from library staff.
- 5. Students are highly satisfied with the dynamic role of Principal in maintenance of discipline and order in the college campus.
- Students raised serious concern about maintenance of hygiene and cleanliness in the toilets/washrooms.
- 7. Students also highlighted about non-availability of safe and clean drinking water in the campus. A significant number of students are not satisfied with the present condition of drinking water facility in the campus.
- 8. Nearly one-fifth students marked neutral to negative remarks on adequacy of power in the campus. It shows there is scope for improvement in power infrastructure of the college.
- 9. Students are highly satisfied with the gymnasium facilities available in the college. Similarly, they are of the opinion that sufficient reading and common room facilities are available in the college.
- 10. Although, a lot of extra-curricular and co-curricular activities including various clubs are available for students, majority of the students are unaware about these facilities. Renewed focus is necessary to be given on creating awareness about availability of these extra-curricular and co-curricular facilities.
